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EXAMINATION CYCLE

1. Internal Exam (After Completion of the at least 40-50% of the syllabus of all courses)

Test 1: Written Test (for 20 marks) + 5 Marks [Attendance]

(Commonly Conducted by the Exam Department for all the courses)

Test 2: Class Test / Viva/PPT/Project Work (for 25 marks)

(Conducted by the subject teacher during lecture hours)

Internal Exam score is calculated on the basis of AVG. marks earned in Test 1 and Test 2 by the students.

2. Semester End Exam: (After Completion of the syllabus / 90days of the course)

Winter Semester End Exam: (Tentatively before Christmas break)

Odd Semester

- SEM I (Theory /Practical as per university guidelines),
- SEM III (Theory /Practical as per university guidelines).

Summer Semester End Exam: (Tentatively in March/April)

Even Semester

- SEM II (Theory/Practical as per university guidelines)
- SEM IV (Theory/Practical as per university guidelines)

All TY examinations for SEM V & VI are conducted at the university level. If the college serves as an Examination Centre for the university exams, the necessary arrangements are made by the Examination Department.
